

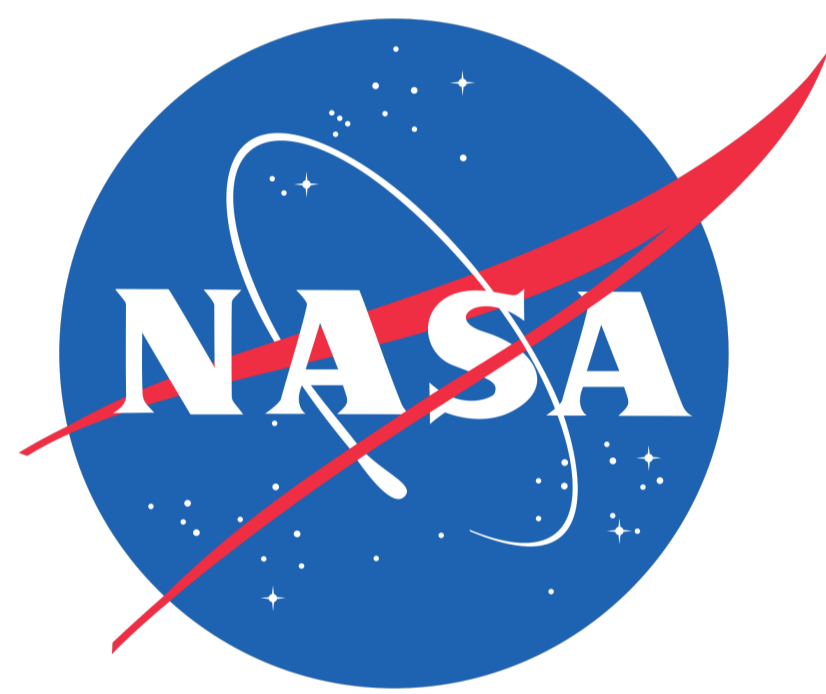
TAT2018 Trans-Atlantic Training

Integration of Radar and Optical Remote Sensing in Studying Land Cover/Land Use Change

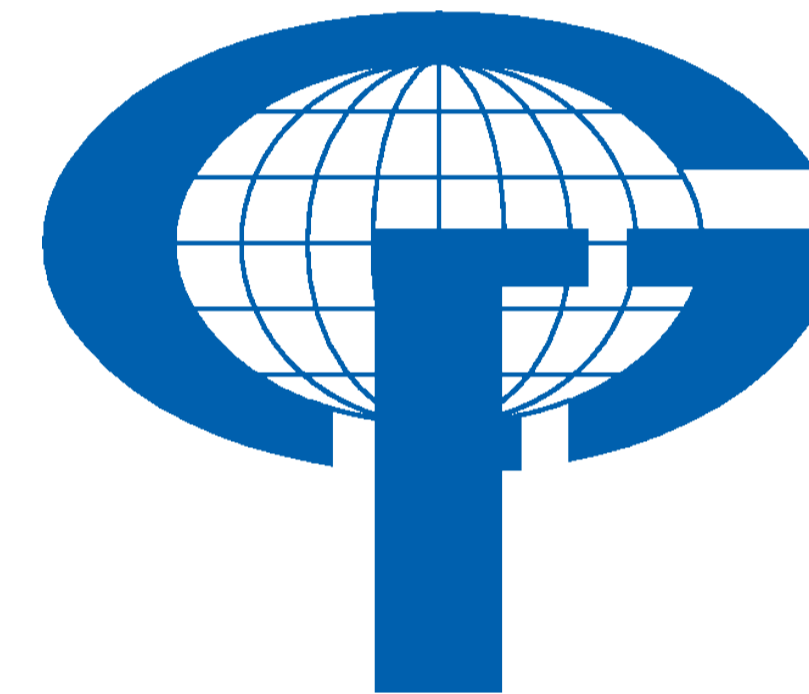
June 7 – 11, 2018, Zagreb, Croatia
